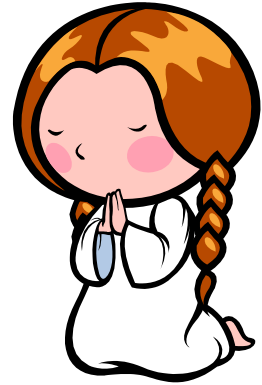


Personal Ministry Plan

"Who, What, Where, When, Why, and How" Approach



I. Why

- A. Pray
- B. State your goal (i.e., "I am doing this project to lead five souls to Jesus)
- C. Stay focused on that goal

II. Where

- A. Choose a location for your project
 - 1. Ask God to help you with your decision
 - 2. Ask: "Is work already being done in this area?"
 - 3. Determine modes of transportation
 - 4. Scope out the land
 - a) *Ask: What are people like?*
 - b) *Ask: What do they need?*

III. Who

- A. Find people of the same mindset and purpose who will help and support you
- B. Choose your target

C. Ask: "Who do I want to target and who can help me do it?"

IV. What

A. Find out what the needs of your target are

B. Develop a list of activities or events that meet those needs

C. Ask: "What can be done to help?"

V. When

A. Assume the amount of time it will take to reach your goal

B. Decide if your project is long term or short term

C. Give yourself a realistic amount of time to carry out and complete your project

VI. How

A. Develop an operation plan

1. Get a name (i.e., Operation: SOS)

2. Give tentative dates and locations for the different segments of your project

B. Go back to your "When" section and alter the time, if necessary.
